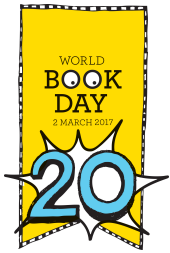

## The Challenge

In the days leading up to World Book Day, teachers and parents start flocking to the website to get ideas and download resources for World Book Day activities. The result is a higher amount of traffic to the site than usual. In addition, social media on World Book Day itself (2 March 2017) drives massive amounts of traffic referrals to the site.

“The site needed to be 100 percent up on that day,” said Nigel Britton, Senior Developer & IT Manager at Complete Control. He added, “because #WorldBookDay trends globally on Twitter throughout the day, the referral traffic from there is huge. The World Book Day site has a ton of content and each page needs to be online despite the major referral traffic from social media.”



## The Solution

Complete Control has entrusted in WP Engine to help support World Book Day's site with their site performance and site uptime needs.

According to Glynn Hayward, there's a build up of traffic two weeks prior to the event, which increases day to day.
